MIGRATION POLICY

MODE OF SELECTION

As per the norms, 30% of total strength of class VIIIth students will be migrated. Out of 30% of students, girls strength would be at 33% rest of the students would be boys. There must be a fair representation of SC & ST students.

- Briefing and orientation of class VIII students to acquaint them with the migration policy and its benefits.
- Submission of willingness application of students those who are willing to go on migration.
- Information to the parents and taking of undertaking from them in this regard.
- Selection of students for migration 2010-11.
- Submission of list of selected students for migration to the District Magistrate for approval.
- Briefing of the selected students for migration regarding reporting to the Vidyalaya and date of departure of students.
- Booking of train tickets for the traveling of students from JNV, to JNV, .
- Preparation of rotation chart of teachers for escort of the students.
